All Out Trail Running Expands with Two Shoes Ready to Run in the Mountains

ROCKFORD, Mich. (June 2014) - Expanding its line of fast and light trail running shoes designed to go the distance, Merrell introduces the All Out Charge and All Out Peak. From fast technical trails to mountain pursuits, trail runners can confidently ascend descend in stride. For a flexible yet stable ride on trails, All Out shoes feature UniFly™, an underfoot wrap that mobilizes the arch and activates the body's natural form by creating continuous ground contact for increased mobility and efficiency.

Other key design features that set All Out running shoes apart include the UniFly™ Impact Protection. This unique design of ultra-resilient, strategically placed foam pads provide a soft landing by dispersing impact for ample protection to go further, faster and longer. A unique M Select Grip outsole uses rubber built in a circular pattern allowing each lug to move independently. This provides multi-directional contact on an increased surface area for a stable and connected ride. A new HyperWrap™ fit system locks the foot in place to enhance stability and agility.

For mountain pursuits, All Out Peak sports 24 mm of cushioning for a soft and connected experience on the trail. A Vibram outsole with 6 mm lug depth offers ample traction to ascend and descend confidently. Total stack height is 32 mm and drop is 6 mm. All Out Peak is also available in a waterproof, breathable GORE-TEX style.

To go the distance on rugged terrain, All Out Charge features 20 mm of cushioning and a Vibram® outsole with 5 mm lug depth. Total stack height is 27 mm with a 6 mm drop.
